



# M.S. MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY

## OVERVIEW

Completion of the degree will offer a path for licensure as a marriage and family therapist in the State of Arizona and prepare students for continued education pursuing doctoral degrees.

Career settings include private practice, residential agencies, acute inpatient treatment (hospitals), day treatment, hospice settings, foster care organizations, churches and other faith communities, and in-home treatment programs.

## REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Undergraduate bachelor's degree from an institutionally accredited organization.
- ◆ Minimum 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA. Students that do not meet this minimum but are within 10% of the required GPA or who have other compelling strengths in their application may be designated by the director of admissions for review by the Graduate Admission Review Board.
- ◆ Contact information for two character references that can be reached if needed. These should be academic or professional references.
- ◆ Evidence in the application of agreement with ACU's statement of faith and core convictions, a deep and credible Christian faith, and vocational fit with the program.
- ◆ Interview with a faculty member
